The **Eb chord** is one of the coolest chords in this song. It's a tricky one to play, but worth the effort to learn

It can be played two ways. Both require you to bar on the 1st fret

Bar 1 with 1st finger & other 3 fingers on 3rd fret


or

Bar 1 with 1st finger & bar 3 strings w/ the ring finger.

You have to bend your ring finger to cover 3 strings

N.B. Once you can do this bar chord, you can play an E chord (bar II), and an F chord (bar III) and a G chord (bar V). Et cetera.
