David D sings the entire song. There are no vocal parts for the band. Strumming pattern: Strum on 2 and 4 beats of each measure. Picking pattern: play a G scale from high to low for the verses (on 1 and 3). For the refrains and bridges, pickers should play alternating bass notes, not the G scale. The refrains and bridges are marked and shaded for clarity.

Intro:

G Scale played a total of 5 times. David plays the scale once by himself to set the tempo, then others join in for a total of 5 G scales.

This picking diagram is for soprano uke or other instruments with A-E-C-G tuning. Pick on the numbers, strum on the rests:
