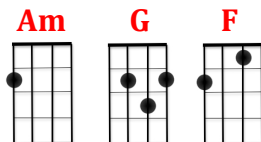


GILLIGAN'S ISLAND

^{Am} the movie star, ^{Am} the professor and Mary Ann, ^G here on Gilligan's Isle.

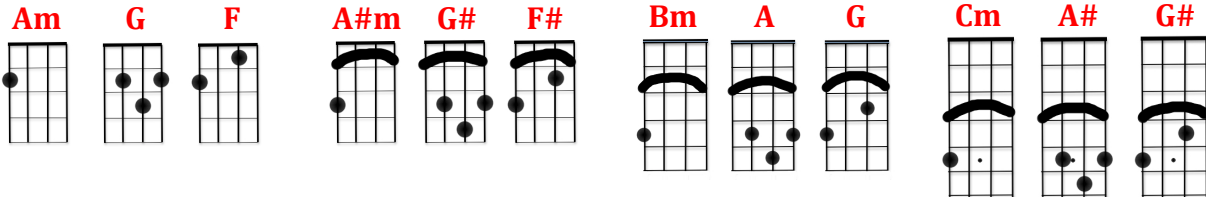
