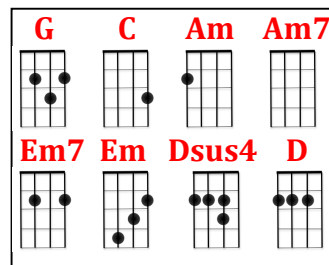


I'm Looking Through You *(minor middle)* - Lennon/McCartney 1965
